

PROCEDURE MANUAL

TRAVEL QUARANTINE POLICY

PURPOSE: To slow the spread of the Virus, COVID-19. This policy is intended to provide guidance for program staff and families who travel to a location in which the State of Ct has deemed at risk due to epidemic/pandemic proportions of individuals with a contagious disease/virus, i.e. COVID-19.

DEFINITIONS: Quarantine keeps someone who might have been exposed to the virus away from others.

POLICY: This Travel Advisory Quarantine Policy is pursuant to Governor Ned Lamont’s Executive Order 7BBB. For the purposes of this policy, the list of states affected is fluid and is being updated weekly on the Connecticut Travel Advisory webpage of Connecticut’s COVID-19 Response website, or at:

PROCEDURE: In compliance with **Executive Order 7BBB**, effective June 25, 2020:

- “Anyone traveling into Connecticut from a state that is listed on the CT Travel Advisory website are directed to self-quarantine for the required 14 days from the last day of contact in the impacted state.
- “This travel advisory also applies to Connecticut residents who are returning from a visit to the impacted states”
- Travelers and those residents who are returning from impacted states should self-quarantine at their home, or a hotel, or other temporary lodging for the required 14 days.
- Any staff member or enrolled family member with travel plans to, or returning from, an impacted state; or having contact with anyone traveling to Connecticut from an impacted state must notify the director or designee as soon as possible with their quarantine plans.
 - Any staff member or enrolled family member who does not self-quarantine for the required 14 days will immediately put on a 14 day suspension, after which they may return to the school or choose to terminate their relationship with the school.
