## Windsor Montessori and Discovery Center's Summer 2022 Upper Elementary weekly themes!

Week 1: Dinosaurs Before Dark. We'll build a volcano; make bookmarks, medallions, paper bag dinosaurs; bake gingerbread children for dinosaurs to eat; climb a rope and ladder; play Predator vs Prey, and much more!

Week 2: Knight at Dawn. We'll assemble a 3D castle puzzle; walk in the woods; bang some drums; juggle some balls; make paper hats; create a journal; draw castles; jump over a moat; have a feast with pie, and much more!
